This \$1,000.00 scholarship is available through the Scholarship Committee of the Missouri Pilots Association. Scholarship(s) are awarded annually, at the discretion of the Board of Directors, to applicants who are enrolled or are planning to enroll in an aviation related curriculum at a Missouri college or university. Award(s) will be made to students pursuing a degree in any field of Aviation, without regard to gender, race, religion or national origin. Through these scholarship(s) the organization hopes to encourage the growth of aviation related industry and education in the state of Missouri.

CRITERIA:

To apply, a student must:

- a. be a full time student in good academic standing at a Missouri institution of higher learning.
- b. be worthy, deserving and of good moral character.
- c. show promise of leadership and academic ability in the field of aviation.

SELECTION PROCESS:

- 1. The recipient(s) of the MPA Scholarship(s) will be recommended by the Scholarship Committee. Recipient(s) shall be approved by the Missouri Pilots Association Board of Directors.
- 2. The application(s) must be delivered or postmarked by April 01. Recipient(s) shall be announced by May 15 of any given year.
- 3. The Educational Endowment Fund Board of Trustees will annually submit the number and award(s) amount to be approved by the MPA Board of Directors. If adequate funding is not available, the Board of Trustees will exercise the option of making no selection.
