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**MISSOURI PILOTS ASSOCIATION  
CONSTITUTION**

**ARTICLE ONE:** The name of the organization shall be the MISSOURI PILOTS ASSOCIATION.

**ARTICLE TWO:** The objects and purposes of the Association may be summed up as:

- A) To operate exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1964 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
- B) To encourage education and safety related to aviation in Missouri through the carrying on of educational, civic and patriotic activities for its members and others.
- C) To sponsor improved educational methods for pilots through publication of factual periodicals, preparation of program material for pilot training, maintaining a library of films and other educational material as will promote safety in aviation.
- D) To provide for its members such programs as will aid them in their activities in connection with aviation and provide centers for discussion and education of matters pertaining to aviation at non-profit meeting places in Missouri.
- E) To cooperate with federal, state and municipal officers and agencies in encouraging the development of aviation in Missouri.
- F) To promote a fraternal feeling among the pilots of the state of Missouri.
- G) To protect the rights and privileges of pilots in the state of Missouri.
- H) To encourage the use of airplanes for business and pleasure among the people of the State of Missouri.
- I) To promote a suitable program in Missouri for the development of adequate landing facilities.
- J) To make available to the people of the state the services of this Association in times of emergency.
- K) To maintain a continuous program in aviation.
- L) To perform all lawful acts authorized for general not-for-profit corporations organized under the laws of the state of Missouri for the uses and purposes for which this corporation is organized. Provided, however, that upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501 © (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the circuit court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purpose; and
- M) To do any and all things which may be necessary or proper in connection with it's purpose.

**ARTICLE THREE:** No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private persons except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

**ARTICLE FOUR:** The duration of the Association shall be perpetual.

MISSOURI PILOTS ASSOCIATION  
BY—LAWS

As amended 6/23/07

ARTICLE I - MEMBERSHIP

- A) CLASSES: Membership in this Association shall be open to either Active or Associate Members.
- B) ACTIVE MEMBERS: Any person holding a valid pilot's certificate issued by the Federal Aviation Administration of the United States at the time of application for membership or later obtained shall be eligible for Active Membership.
- C) ASSOCIATE MEMBERS: Any person, firm, corporation or organization desiring to further the objectives of this Association shall be eligible for Associate Membership.
- D) DUAL MEMBERS: A husband and wife who are both either an Active or an Associate Member and who have the same mailing address.
- E) PRIVILEGES: Active and Associate members shall be entitled to all privileges and rights of the Association.
- F) APPLICATION: Application for membership shall be made on forms provided by the Association. Such application shall be approved by the Board of Directors or such officers as may be authorized by the Board to approve the same.
- G) DUES: The annual dues of the Association shall be such amount as is fixed from time to time by the Board of Directors. New members shall be considered to be in good standing for a twelve month period and renewal dues shall be due and payable in subsequent years in the month of original affiliation.
- H) EXPULSION: The Board of Directors, after due notice and a hearing if requested, may recommend to the membership the expulsion of any member who brings discredit to himself or the Association.
- I) DELINQUENCIES: Any member who is more than three months delinquent in the payment of dues shall be automatically suspended until such dues are fully paid, and, if not paid within six months after payment is due, such members shall be dropped from the Association.

ARTICLE II - ANNUAL AND SPECIAL MEETINGS

- A) ANNUAL MEETING: The annual meeting of the Association shall be held at such time and place during the months of April, May or June of each year as the Board of Directors shall select.
- B) SPECIAL MEETINGS. Special meetings may be called at such times and places as the Board of Directors may by resolution determine, or, upon the written request of ten members delivered to the Secretary, the President shall call a special meeting to convene in Jefferson City, Missouri.
- C) NOTICE OF MEETINGS. At least thirty days written notice of all meetings shall be given to all members in good standing. In the case of special meetings, the notice shall state the purpose of the meeting and the business to be transacted.
- D) ORDER OF BUSINESS: The order of business at any meeting of the Association shall be as follows:
1. Calling the roll
  2. Approval of the minutes of the previous meeting
  3. Report of the President
  4. Treasurer's report
  5. Committee reports
  6. Old business
  7. New business
  8. Election of directors (at annual meeting).
- E) QUORUM: The quorum necessary to transact business at any meeting shall be twenty members, provided that a lesser number may adjourn until a future date, not exceeding thirty days. If the adjournment is over ten days, five days notice of the date and place of holding the adjourned meeting shall be given in writing to all members.
- F) RULES OF ORDER: Questions of procedure shall be decided according to Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised, unless otherwise provided in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE III - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- A) ELECTIONS: There shall be elected at the annual meeting each year by the active and associate members of the Association in good standing a Board of Directors of sixteen members, one third to be elected each year. Directors shall also be elected to fill any vacancy caused by any reason of a director for the unexpired term. In

addition to the above sixteen elected members of the Board of Directors, the president of each local chapter of the Missouri Pilots Association shall automatically become a member of the Board of Directors for his/her term of office; any past president of the Missouri Pilots Association who is currently a member in good standing shall become a member of the Board of Directors; the Treasurer, Secretary, Legal Counsel, Web Master and Editor shall also become members of the Board of Directors, all of which shall have all the duties, responsibilities and voting powers of the elected members of the Board.

B) **QUALIFICATIONS:** Candidates for membership on the Board of Directors shall have been members of the Association for a period of at least one year when elected, and shall not hold any office or position for compensation with any federal or state government aviation unit or agency at the time of election or during their term of office.

C) **TERM:** Each member of the Board of Directors shall hold office for a term of three years except those members who are automatically members of the Board of Directors by reason of the fact that they are a president of a local chapter, or treasurer, secretary, legal counsel, or editor or Webmaster of the Missouri Pilots Association, who shall remain in office only for the duration of their term in such office.

D) **COMPENSATION:** Directors shall not receive any compensation for their services.

E) **REPRESENTATION:** Directors shall be so elected as to provide representation on the Board to various areas of the state whenever possible. The Board may, if it deems it desirable, divide the state into not less than seven districts and one out-of-state district for a total of eight districts. In such event, at least one member of the Board shall be elected by the entire membership from each such district.

F) **MEETINGS:** The Board of Directors shall hold an annual meeting immediately following the annual meeting of the Association each year. The Board may hold such other meetings at such time and places as it shall determine by resolution. Special meetings may be called by the President or by any five members of the Board. Special meetings shall be held at such place or places as shall be determined by the President. Ten days notice in writing shall be given of all meetings.

G) **QUORUM:** A quorum to transact business at any regular or special meeting of the Board of Directors shall consist of six members of the Board.

H) **DUTIES:** The Board of Directors shall control, manage and administer the business and affairs of the Association. The Board shall promote and carry out the objectives of the Association, perform and carry out any resolutions and directives of the Association as expressed in its annual or special meetings, elect and supervise the work of the officers of the Association, account for and administer the funds and property of the Association, and shall possess all powers and authority necessary to perform the above duties.

I) **COMMITTEES:** The President with the approval of the Board of Directors shall appoint for terms of one year such committees as he/she shall deem necessary to carry out the work of the Association, including, but not limited to, the following: membership, air tour and activity, education, legislative, airport, safety, public relations and publicity. The membership and functions of all committees shall be determined by the Board of Directors. Each committee shall make an annual report to the Association at its annual meeting and such other reports to the Board of Directors as the Board of Directors from time to time may request.

#### ARTICLE IV - OFFICERS AND DUTIES

A) **OFFICERS:** The officers of the Association shall consist of a President, 1st Vice President, 2nd Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. No two offices can be held by one person except the offices of Secretary and Treasurer.

B) **ELECTION:** The said officers shall be elected by the Board of Directors at its annual meeting each year for terms of one year, beginning the following July 1. The President shall have served at least two full years on the Board of Directors and be an Active member of the Association, and the 1st and 2nd Vice Presidents shall have served at least one full year as member of the Board of Directors; provided, however, that neither the President nor the 1st and 2nd Vice President shall be required to be actively serving as a Director of the Association at the time of the election.

C) **PRESIDENT:** The President shall preside at all meetings of the Association and of the Board of Directors. He shall administer and carry on the work of the Association under the direction of and subject to the approval of the Board of Directors. He shall report annually to the Board of Directors and to the Association on the work of the Association for the past year and submit his recommendations for future activities.

D) **VICE PRESIDENT:** The 1st Vice President's responsibilities shall be membership, legislation, the annual meeting and as otherwise designated by the President. The 2nd Vice President's duties shall pertain to air shows, fly-ins, dedications, proficiency events, and as otherwise designated by the President. In the event of an untimely vacancy, the ascension of subordinate officers shall be automatic and the Board shall appoint a member to fill the

vacancy of the 2nd Vice President.

E) SECRETARY: The Secretary shall keep accurate and complete minutes of the Association and of the Board of Directors. He/she shall keep and maintain all records of the Association, shall issue all notices and announcements, and shall issue correspondence for the Association upon order of the Board of Directors. He/she shall retain custody of the seal of the Association.

F) TREASURER: The Treasurer shall have custody of all of the funds of the Association, shall collect the monies of the Association, shall keep accurate books of account thereof and report to the Board and Association at each meeting thereof as to the financial condition of the Association. He/she shall pay out of the funds of the Association according to the budget or upon order of the Board of Directors. The Treasurer shall maintain an accurate roll of membership of the Association, shall issue all membership dues statements, shall maintain accurate records concerning each member of the Association, and shall report to the Board and Association at each meeting thereof as to the membership condition of the Association. He/she shall issue to each Chapter President the list of delinquent Chapter members prior to dropping those members from the roll of membership, and shall furnish to the Board of Directors any membership statistics required for the selection of award recipients. The Treasurer shall submit a proposed budget for the ensuing year at the July board meeting for the Board's approval. He/she shall provide such bond, at the cost of the Association, as may be required by the Board.

G) OTHER PERSONNEL: The Board of Directors may appoint from time to time such other officers, agents or employees of the Association as shall be deemed necessary and the Board shall set the scope and authority of said persons.

H) EXECUTIVE SECRETARY: The Board of Directors may, from time to time, appoint for such term as they determine an executive secretary and may fix his or her compensation for serving as such.

#### **ARTICLE V - SEAL**

The seal of the Association shall consist of an emblem as selected by the Board of Directors and a copy of said seal shall be displayed in the minutes of the Board of Directors.

#### **ARTICLE VI - FISCAL YEAR**

The fiscal year of the Association shall begin on July 1<sup>st</sup> and end on June 30<sup>th</sup> of the ensuing year.

#### **ARTICLE VII - PUBLICATIONS**

The official organ of the Association shall be a publication to be titled "MPA News" which shall be distributed to the membership with regularity. The Board of Directors shall select a person to serve as editor.

#### **ARTICLE VIII - AMENDMENTS**

These bylaws may be amended by a majority vote of all active and associate members of the Association present and voting at any annual meeting of the Association, or any special meeting called for that purpose. Thirty days notice setting forth the purpose and language of the proposed amendment shall be given to all members in good standing. For purposes of this article, notice may be given by publication in the M.P.A. News, and shall be deemed given on the date of mailing of such publication, or may be mailed to the members in good standing, in which case the notice shall be deemed given on the date that the notice is placed in the United States Mail, postage prepaid, addressed to each member of the Association.

#### **ARTICLE IX - CHAPTERS**

A) Any group of at least ten members in good standing of the Association may, if approved by action of the Board of Directors, form a chapter of the association. Any such chapter shall have objectives, governance and activities which are compatible with the constitution and bylaws of the Association.

B) Each member of the Association shall be considered to be a member of the chapter situated in the section of the Association in which the member resides unless otherwise specified by the member in writing to the Secretary. In the event that more than one chapter *is* situated within a particular section, each member of that section shall designate upon admission to membership in the Association the chapter to which the member wishes to be affiliated. A member may at any time after admission to membership in the Association change his or her chapter affiliation by notification in writing to the Secretary. The Treasurer of the Association shall rebate to each chapter such portion of each member's annual dues as is directed by action of the Board of Directors. In the event a member has failed to designate a chapter affiliation, the chapter dues for such member shall be divided between all chapters situated in that section in which said member resides. The Treasurer shall make payments of the rebate to the designated chapters on a quarterly basis.

- May 18, 1973 Revised constitution and bylaws adopted.
- Jul. 1, 1973 Ozarks Chapter recognized and adopted.
- Jul. 1974 Ken Hurt became Editor of the MPA News.
- Nov. 1, 1974 SEMO Chapter reorganized and accepted.
- Dec. 14, 1975 NEMO and Lakes County Chapters recognized and accepted.
- Mar. 18, 1976 Active members reached 1,000 for the first time.
- May 15, 1976 Pony Express Chapter was recognized and accepted.
- Jul. 11, 1976 Mid-Missouri Chapter recognized and accepted.
- Apr. 30, 1977 Gateway Chapter recognized and accepted.

## **BLACKFORD TROPHY** **(Outstanding member of MPA Board of Directors)**

Vincent Blackford was President of the MPA for the year 1962-1963. As President, he recognized the very important contributions members of the Board of Director made to the betterment and success of the Missouri Pilots Association. To recognize the member of the board who had done the most outstanding job as a director during his term, he created and awarded a trophy which was hence forth named the Blackford Trophy.

Vince suggested that members of the board, not the president, select future winners. As a result, the board selects the member to be honored who they feel has done the most outstanding job as director.

The first recipient, George Tallen, served as president of MPA in 1960-1961. The trophy has been presented for more than 40 years. Each award winner keeps the trophy until the next annual meeting, when it is presented to the new recipient. Repairs have been needed over the years and it will soon need a second deck to find a place to inscribe future award winners names.

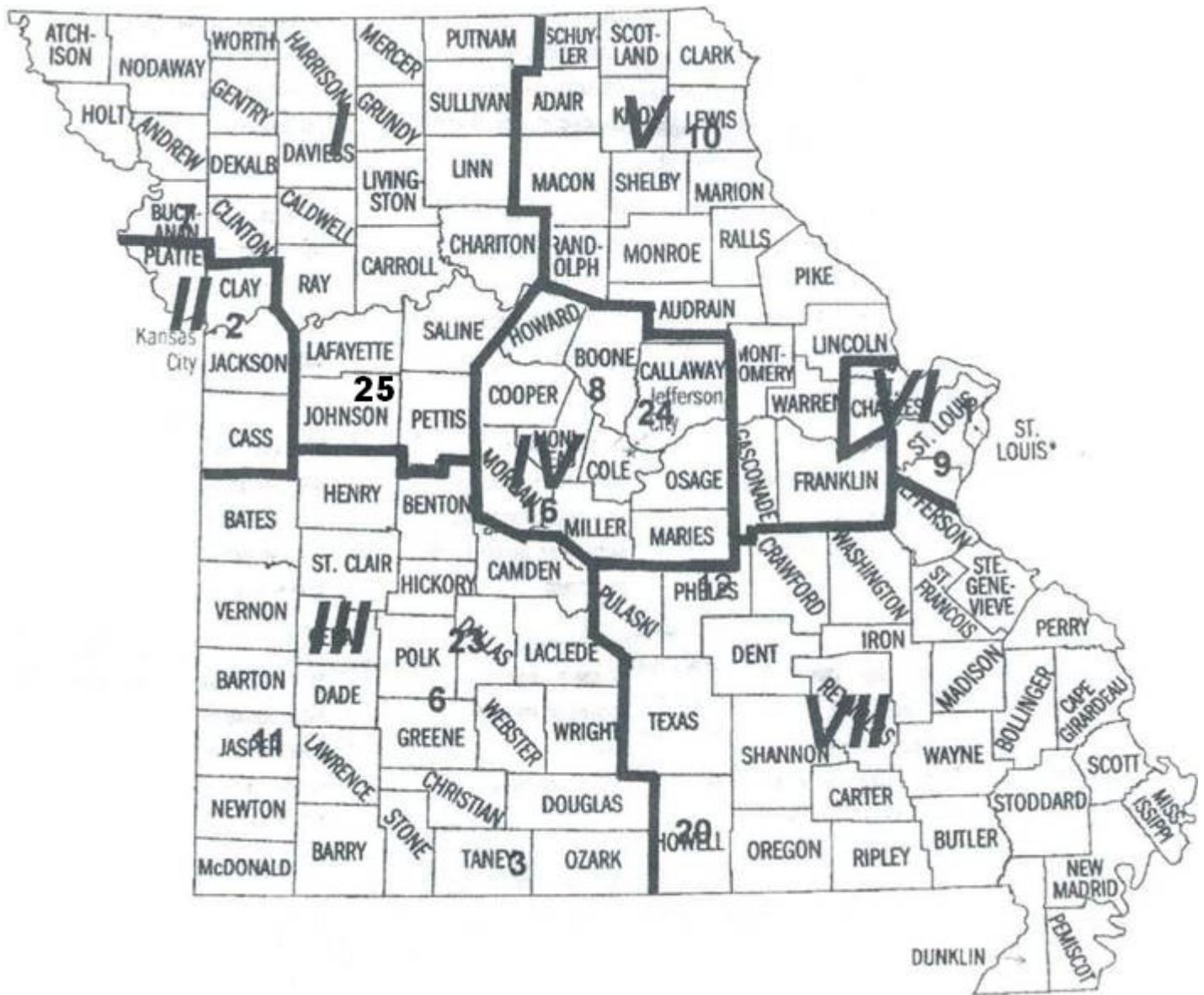
