

KWDG'S 13th Annual Poker Run

And Fly-In Breakfast

Enid Woodring Regional Airport will be hosting its 13th Annual Poker Run.

All proceeds will go to the Garfield Child Advocacy Council.

DATE: 17 September 2022

ENTRY: Pilots **and/or** their passengers (passengers need not be pilots)

REGISTRATION: Pre-Register with Mason at Woodring via phone or email.

LOCATION: Enid Woodring Regional Airport (KWDG)

FEE: \$30.00 per participant (cash/ check donation made out to the **Garfield County Advocacy Council**)

T-SHIRT: One Free with registration

START TIME: 8:15 AM @ WDG

Briefing: There will be a mandatory safety briefing at 8:00 AM in the Joint-

Use planning room at WDG

FINISH TIME: 11:00 AM @ WDG

Rules:

You must start at WDG. It is recommended that you go counter-clockwise for air safety.

Recommended course:

1. KWDG — F22 25 NM, 090° course
2. F22— KPNC 12 NM, 021° course
3. KPNC— WDG 22 NM, 240° course

Total round-trip distance: 87 NM

- 1) Participating airports are:

Ponca City, OK **KPNC**; Perry, OK **KF22**; Enid Woodring, Enid, OK **KWDG**.

- 2) Participants will receive one sealed envelope containing one card at each airport stop, including when departing and arriving at Woodring. The last envelope to be received at Woodring will have 2 cards inside.
- 3) Upon arrival at a participating airport, exit the runway as soon as practical, and taxi to the Poker Run official or official cardholder area to collect one sealed envelope containing one card.
- 4) You must present 5 UNOPENED (SEALED) envelopes to event officials at WOODRING Airport, **NO LATER** than **11AM**.
- 5) Event officials will open each participant's envelopes to determine their "poker hand".
- 6) Pilots do not have to fly to every airport. In lieu of landing at a specific airport, you may elect to make an additional **\$10.00 DONATION** to the **Garfield County Child Advocacy Council** for the missing card.
- 7) Participants then play their poker hands at Woodring using their accumulated cards.
- 8) **The official poker game rules will be maintained by Mason Brinley at WDG.**

Pilots are expected to utilize standard traffic patterns and radio calls at each airport to maximize safety and to reduce to potential for midair collisions. It is absolutely imperative that every pilot be aware of the risks and hazards associated with traffic operations in a non-towered environment.

Be especially vigilant for propeller hazards while on the ground!

All participants will receive a \$.50/gallon discount from full service
